The winning combination of fairy-tale adventure and concrete safety information provide the perfect starting point for discussions with children about stranger safety.

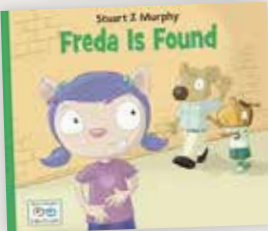


### ***Fireboy to the Rescue! A Fire Safety Book***

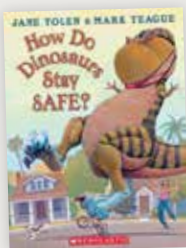
### ***No Dragons for Tea: Fire Safety for Kids (and Dragons)***
